Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff **2175**

Our charge includes Funeral counseling, necessary arrangements, recording vital statistics, securing permits, filing and obtaining death certificates and other forms and claims, preparation of necessary notices and the of service plans with parties involved in the final disposition of the deceased. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, Immediate burials and forwarding or receiving remains).

Embalming **875**

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming you have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or Immediate burial.
